## STRUCTURE, CONTENT AND ADMISSION

The two Institutions of higher learning are joining forces to offer collectively a two-year, full-time Master of Science Degree program combining International Maritime Law and Maritime and Humanitarian Logistics. With this master program the Institutions are responding to the call of governments and representatives of industry around the world who need persons educated in international legal matters pertaining to the sea but also need to understand the complex industrial use of the sea for services and for the transportation of goods.

### COURSE STRUCTURE

This prestigious English language program is divided in two parts: international maritime law courses taught primarily at IMLI, and logistics and leadership courses taught primarily at KLU. In this regard, students will spend the first academic year studying in Malta and the second in Hamburg. The first summer includes a dissertation project, the second a thesis. The curriculum also contains integrative material linking the legal and logistics aspects of the subjects and faculty of the two Institutions.

## ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Applicants are required to hold a Bachelor's Degree in Business, Economics or Law or a relevant field from a recognized university.
- Graduates of other fields with significant components in Economics and/or Business, are also eligible.
- Proof of command of the English language is required.

## TUITION FEES

The program is a two-year program and tuition fees amount to € 18,500 per year. Participants who pay in full the tuition fees for both years before the beginning of the program will benefit from a € 2,000 rebate on the total. A non-refundable application fee of € 200 will be deducted from the tuition fees if the applicant is accepted to the program.

## IMO – INTERNATIONAL MARITIME LAW INSTITUTE IMLI, MALTA

IMLI was established under the auspices of the International Maritime Organization, a specialized agency of the United Nations, as an international center for the training of specialists in maritime law. It offers a Master of Laws (LL.M.) program, a Research Degree program, an Advanced Diploma program and several short courses.

Through its programs and courses the Institute contributes to the development and dissemination of knowledge and expertise in international maritime law, with special reference to the international regulations and procedures for safety, security and efficiency of shipping and the prevention of marine pollution. The main purpose of the Institute is to assist governments, particularly those of developing countries, to implement IMO treaties and other international legal instruments. It provides suitably qualified candidates with high-level facilities for advanced training, study and research in international maritime law. Particular focus is placed on legislative drafting techniques designed to assist participants in the process of incorporating international treaty rules into domestic law.
